3- Choose the right alternative.

Education is not only a human right in itself, but also a primary vehicle for people to raise themselves (**out-up-away**) of poverty and to gain the ability to participate fully in their communities. The UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, ratified by Kenya, (**state- states- stated**) that all children have a right to good (**quantity-type-quality**) education that is effective, relevant, non-discriminatory and (**culture-cultural-culturally**) appropriate. The Act emphasizes and (**promotes-discourages-prevents**) equal education opportunities for girls and boys, with the need to address cultural, religious and other forms of biases particularly against girls. However, Kenya's basic education sector continues to experience (**gender-ethnic-racial**) disparity where girls are more disadvantaged, with major social cultural factors including (**late-early-tardy**) child marriage, Female Genital Mutilation and child labour. While household poverty is also a (**contributing-contributed-contribution**) factor, preference of boys' education compared to that of girls' by parents and communities.
