### The Text :

\_ A new camp in Germany is trying to keep children who spend too much time on the internet out of their bedrooms and into the sunshine. The camp is located in Boltenhagen, northern Germany on the coast of the Baltic Sea.

Children at the camp are encouraged to spend as much time as possible outdoors and their daily computer time is reduced to 30 minutes. Most teens who attend the camp are addicts who use the web and computer games for up to six hours a day. Moritz Moeller, 13, said, "It was fun playing on the computer because I was bored. My friends had no time for me." A teenage girl at the camp said: "My mum always told me to go out and do some sport but I much preferred to play on the computer."

Supervisors take the children to the beach every day. They swim and do aerobics before a healthy lunch. Camp organizers say that diet and exercise are key aspects of the camp's strategy: Children who sit in front of the computer all day tend to eat badly and rarely move away from their seats.

Benjamin Saenger, a teenager who weighs 123 kilos, loved to play car-racing computer games. He said he became aware that he was putting on weight. "I thought the camp was going to be **dreadful** because there were no computers, nor any TV – only sport," he said. "But I wanted to feel better, and I do feel more self-confident now. There's far more to life than sitting in front of a computer all day long. You should exercise and look after your diet."

After the camp, the kids said they felt much happier and many of them promised to limit the amount of time they will spend on their computers at home.


